Dental bridges

Simply put, a dental bridge is a non-removable false tooth used to fill in the space left by a missing tooth. We place two crowns onto teeth on each side of the missing tooth, supporting a new restoration to 'bridge' the gap.

When placed, your dental bridge is completely natural in appearance, and usually requires just two visits to your 1300SMILES practice. Dental bridges are an extremely functional way to replace missing teeth, and in conjunction with dental crowns, can give you an aesthetically pleasing and durable smile.

Bridges can reduce your risk of gum disease, help correct some bite issues and can even improve your speech. With good oral hygiene, your new bridge can last as long as ten years or more.

We Care™ about the changing condition of your teeth as you travel through life's journey. And as you age, you may find that your teeth become less structurally sound, or that for various reasons, one or more teeth need to be removed.

Lost fillings, tooth decay, root canal work, and chipped or cracked enamel are some of the common issues that can affect your teeth. Fortunately, a dental crown or bridge from 1300SMILES may be the ideal solution for the smile you've always dreamed of.

Dental crowns

Your 1300SMILES dentist may recommend a crown for many reasons, such as functionality (usually for the back teeth) or aesthetics (usually front teeth).

When most of the surface of the tooth is a problem, but the root system is intact, a crown may be your ideal restorative or cosmetic solution for a beautiful new smile.

Your dental crown will cover the entire visible part of your tooth, which makes them an ideal restoration for teeth that are broken, fractured, chipped or missing large fillings.

With dental crowns, you will find your natural teeth's appearance is greatly improved, and your smile is brighter and straighter.

Crowns can be made from a variety of materials, including gold alloy and several types of ceramics; but most commonly from porcelain for its functional strength and close match to your natural teeth.

Placing your dental crown

Constructing your dental crown usually involves just two appointments at your 1300SMILES practice. During your first visit, your dentist will prepare your tooth by removing a small amount of your tooth's surface, and making an impression mould. We will then place a temporary crown over your tooth while your crown is made.

Our dental technicians will construct your crown at our laboratory, over about three weeks. We then invite you to return to your 1300SMILES practice, where your temporary crown is removed and your definitive crown placed.

Then, if you are completely happy with your crown's appearance, and your dentist is happy with the technical fit, your new crown is cemented in. Your beautiful new smile is now ready to display!
