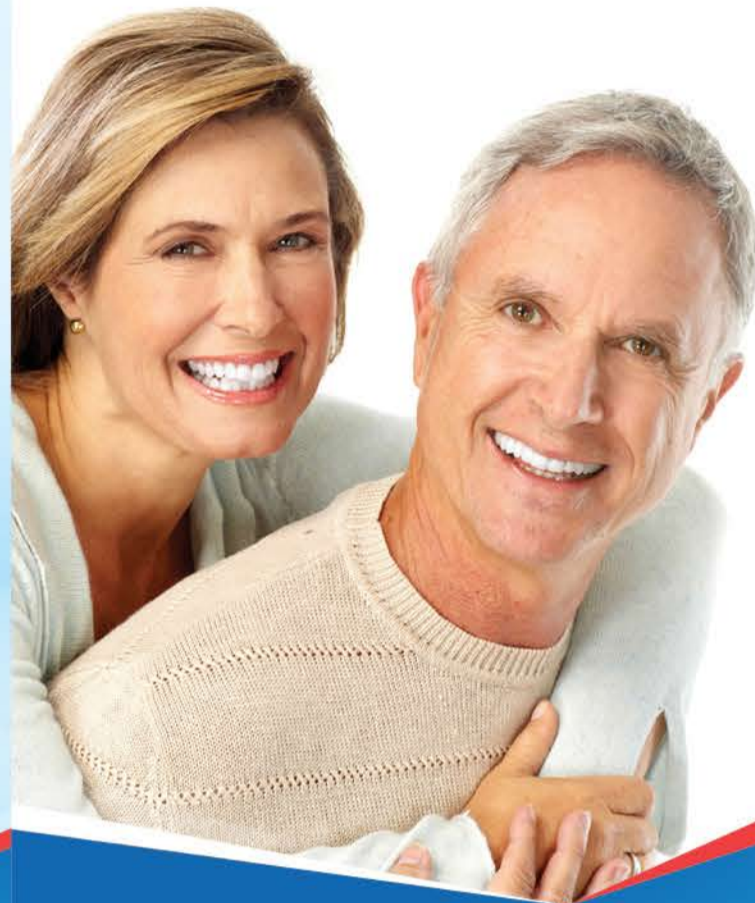

We Care™ about tooth loss. We understand that losing your natural teeth is something that will affect your entire life. The structure of your mouth can change, and you may even experience headaches, jaw and neck pain.

Tooth loss may cause you to be more conscious about your smile, and functionally, you may be unable to eat certain foods. Fortunately, dental implants can offer a permanent solution to missing teeth, to truly change your life.

Dental Implants

At 1300SMILES, we understand that missing teeth can cause a lack of confidence to smile, to eat in public or to speak with self-assurance. Missing teeth can also have a severe negative affect on your health. We Care™ about providing natural-looking options for replacing missing teeth, such as dental implants.

An implant is a small titanium pin that is surgically placed in the jawbone to replace a missing tooth root. A suitable new tooth replacement, such as a porcelain crown, is then secured to the implant, providing you with a natural looking replacement.

Implants are a fixed, permanent solution to restore one or several missing teeth, allowing you to eat what you want, when you want, and best of all to have a natural, healthy and confident smile. Speak to your 1300SMILES dentist about experiencing the strength, comfort and freedom of dental implants.

Placing your dental implant

Your 1300SMILES team will first ensure your gums and jawbone are healthy, and able to support your new tooth replacement. We will check your mouth for any sign of gum disease, which must be treated before an implant can be successfully placed.

Because your implant will become an intimate part of your mouth, we will thoroughly ensure that conditions are suitable for your new implant to fuse with your jawbone correctly, providing stability for your restoration for life.

At your first appointment, your dentist will make a small incision in your gum line under local anaesthetic, allowing the implant to be guided into the correct position as determined by x-ray examinations. Your implant is then allowed to heal for a period of three to six months, ensuring the implant bonds naturally with the jawbone.
